

BYLAW NO. 13/66

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LUMSDEN IN THE PROVINCE
OF SASKATCHEWAN TO CHANGE THE NAMES OF CERTAIN
STREETS AND AVENUES IN THE TOWN OF LUMSDEN

The Council of the Town of Lumsden, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Each of the streets set out in the Column B of the schedule marked A hereto annexed and forming part of this bylaw shall have its name changed and shall henceforth be known as the name set out in the said schedule under item C entitled "New Designations".


2. On the passing of this bylaw all proper officers of the Town shall take appropriate action to carry the said changes into effect and have the registered plans affected properly amended.

3. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.


INTRODUCED AND READ a first time this 12th day of December, A.D. 1966.

READ a third time by unanymous vote of all members of the Council present and finally passed this 12th day of December, A.D. 1966.




