



How to Recycle, Properly!

Ensure all blue bin materials are clean, dry and free of any debris.
Flatten all cardboard. Include **only** appropriate materials in your blue bin.
Tell your friends!

Do Include

- CARDBOARD, BOXBOARD, NEWSPAPER, JUNK MAIL, MAGAZINES, OFFICE PRINT
- TIN AND ALUMINUM CANS
- PLASTIC CONTAINERS AND MILK JUGS
- PLASTICS LABELLED 1 THROUGH 7 (SEE EXCEPTION IN NEXT COLUMN)

Do NOT Include

- CLAM SHELL TYPE FOOD CONTAINERS (LABELLED NUMBER 1)
- PLASTIC WRAP OR ANY TYPE OF PLASTIC BAGS
- OIL CONTAINERS OR CHEMICAL JUGS
- DIRTY OR SOILED MATERIALS
- USED TISSUES OR DIAPERS
- TOYS
