



# ABOUT LUMSDEN

## NEED TO KNOW

### RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE SCHEDULE

Tuesday mornings - **north** of the railroad tracks  
Thursday mornings - **south** of the railroad tracks  
(see the town website for specific dates).

### RECYCLING SCHEDULE

Crown and Shred pick-up dates are every **second Thursday** morning (see the town website for specific dates). Refer to the town website to learn about acceptable recycling materials and bin placement.

### LANDFILL INFORMATION

The Lumsden Landfill is open from Wednesdays to Saturdays (varying hours). Please see town website for specific hours and fees.

### PRAIRIE VALLEY SCHOOL DIVISION

Lumsden has an elementary school with a French immersion option, as well as a high school. Both schools are located on Broad Street. Please see town website for more information.

### COUNCIL MEETINGS

Town Council meetings are generally held twice a month, every **2nd** and **4th Tuesday** evenings at 6:30pm. The meetings are open for public observation town office or via Zoom.

## RECREATION

### LIBRARY

The Lumsden Library branch belongs to the South East Regional libraries. Located on 3rd Avenue next to the Sports Centre, check out a book today or call (306) 731-BOOK!

### LIONS PARK

Located right on James Street, bordered by the river dike, Lions Park is equipped with two playground areas, 18-hole disc golf course, soccer field, and public washrooms.

### LUMSDEN HISTORICAL MUSEUM

Located on Qu'Appelle Drive West, the Lumsden Historical Museum is in operation from May to September.

### OFF LEASH DOG PARK

Lumsden's off-leash dog park located at 50 Aspen Bay, behind Lumsden's Heritage Home. Dogs must be licensed to visit!

### QU'APPELLE VALLEY NORDIC SKI CLUB

### RIVERPARK

RiverPark is home to Lumsden's campground, ball diamonds, spray park, playground, and canteen. Ample parking available for commuters during the day, and park users in the evenings.

### SPECIAL EVENTS

Lumsden Duck Derby is an annual fundraising event held every labour day long weekend. Generally hosted at River Park (weather pending). Don't forget to buy your ducks! Funds support the Lumsden Rink! Lumsden Scarecrow Festival. Display your scarecrows to celebrate in the fall festivities. Held the third Saturday in September, this is a FULL day of family friendly activities at various locations around town!

### CENTENNIAL HALL

This beautiful and historic building hosts several community activities. Located on 3rd Avenue, it is the perfect venue to book for your next gathering.

### LUMSDEN SPORTS CENTRE (RINK)

Home to a range of hockey programs, as well as figure skating, and curling. Next door to the Sports Centre is a full-sized outdoor skating rink in the winter.

### CHURCHES AND FAITH BASED VENUES

You'll find several churches ranging in denominations within Lumsden. All Saints Anglican Church, Saint Peters Roman Catholic Church, Rock of the Valley Community Church, St. Andrews United Church, Shepherd of the Valley Lutheran Church. See website for further information.
